Overview of Project and Scope of Work



SERIES 1 PRIORITIES

- **Safety and security**
 - Install interior doors at elementary school classrooms
- **Age of the school site**
 - Modernize eligible schools over 25 years old
- **Projects that will impact the greatest amount of students**
 - Projects for high schools and middle schools, which benefit most Irvine USD students, who will attend these schools
- **Upgrade Science Labs at middle schools**



Why Move?

- **Student and staff safety** – Springbrook will be an active construction site with several work crews, construction equipment and vehicles. In addition, there will also be debris, dust and noise that generally accompanies such projects.
- **Minimal disruption to the learning environment for our students.** Our students will be in a learning space that is comparable to Springbrook, without the disruption and safety concerns of heavy construction on campus.
- Rather than spreading the work out over multiple years, which would make our school an ongoing and active construction site, **the work will be done within a one-year timeframe.** This means, our students and families will experience the benefits of Measure E upgrades in the 2020-2021 school year.

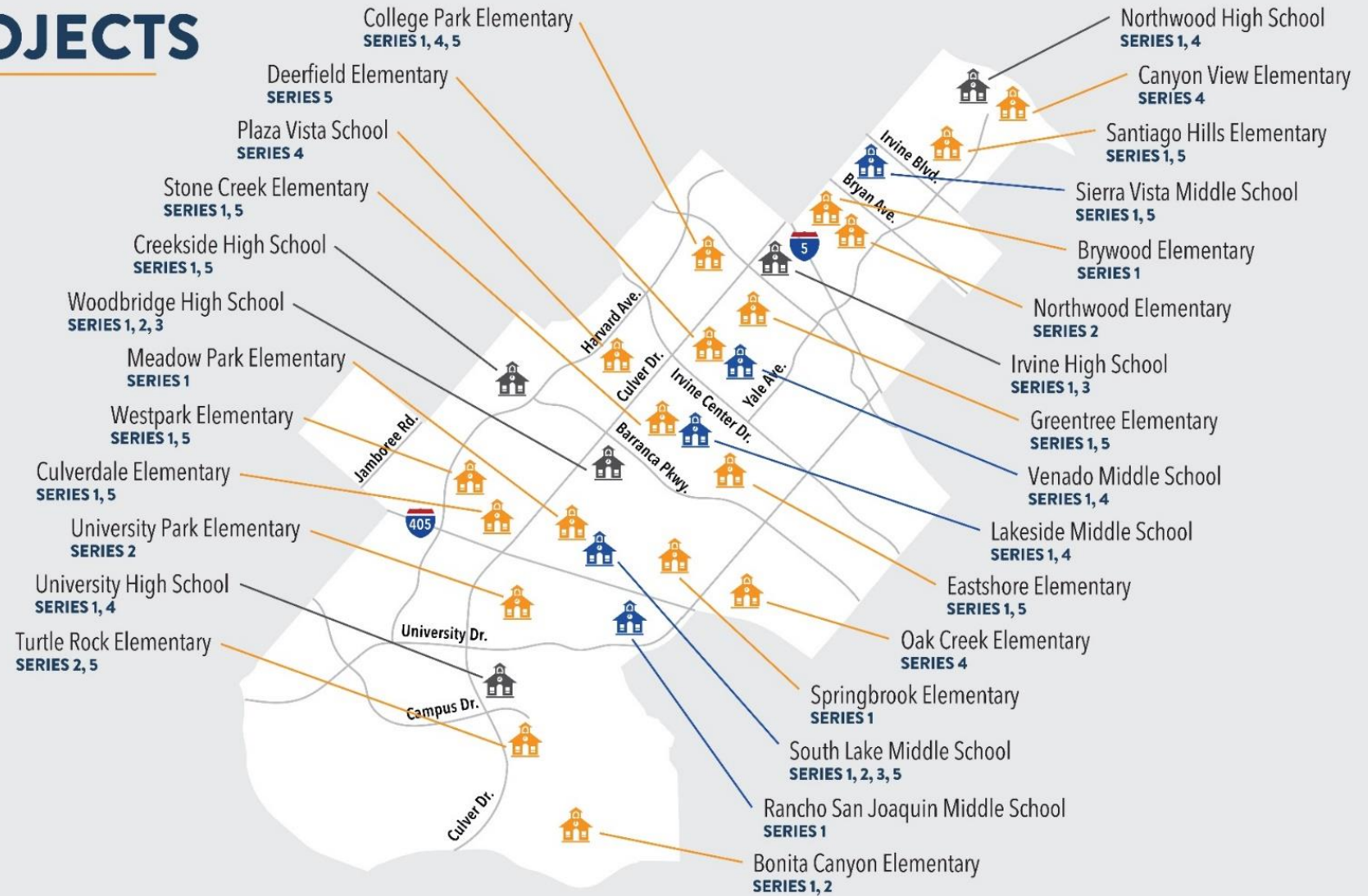
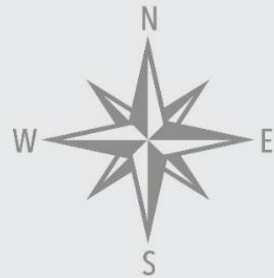

- 1** **Modernize Facilities Over 25 Years of Age**
Modernization includes the following work, as required and as funding is available.
Code Upgrades:
 - Accessibility requirements, path-of-travel, restrooms, casework, signage.
 - New fire alarm system and devices.
 - New public address system.
 - Energy and water conservation, new plumbing fixtures.Building System Upgrades:
 - HVAC system upgrades, duct work and controls (6 classrooms).
 - Minor security upgrades.
 - Re-roofing, as required for HVAC upgrades.Functional Improvements:
 - New flexible furniture allocation.
 - New classroom audio/visual systems.
 - Network upgrades (wireless access).
 - Creation of flexible collaborative spaces near classrooms.
 - Reconfiguration of some spaces to support the program functional needs.
 - New casework.
 - New flooring, ceiling and wall finishes.
 - New equipment for kitchen and expansion of space.Other Improvements

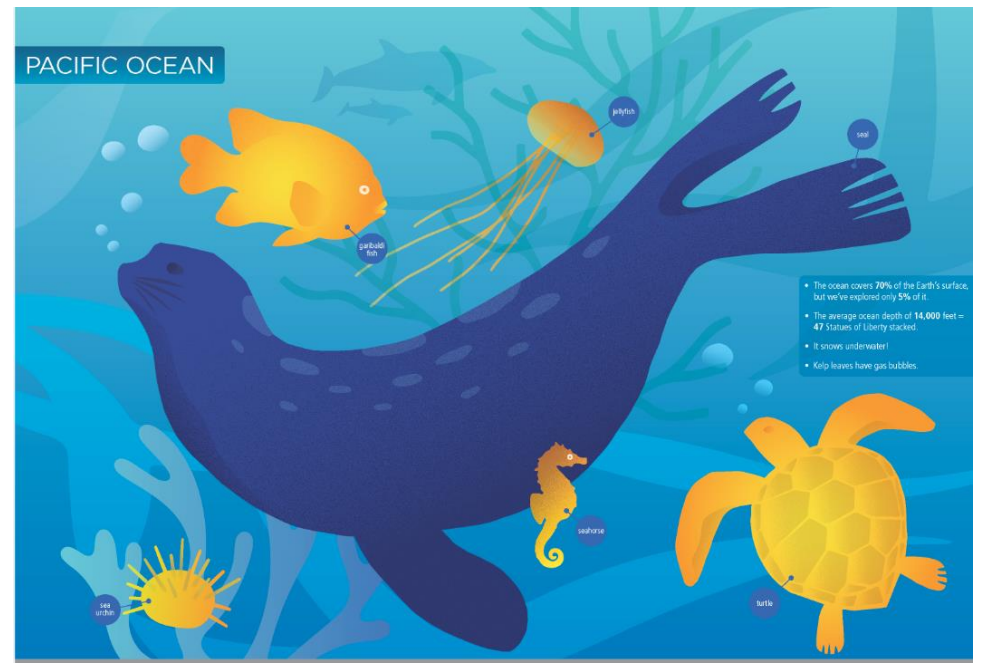
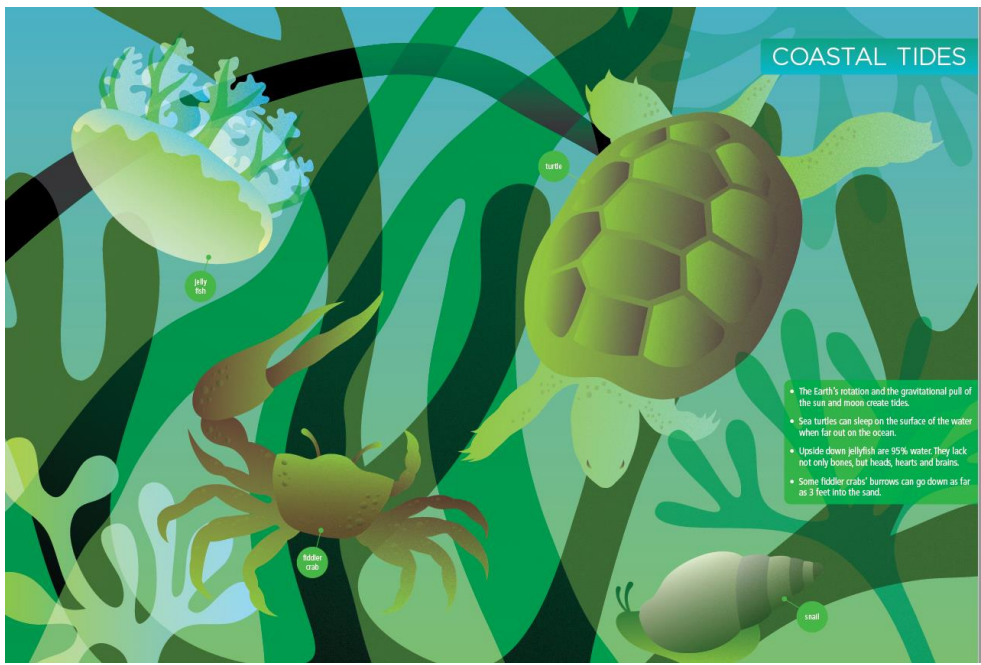

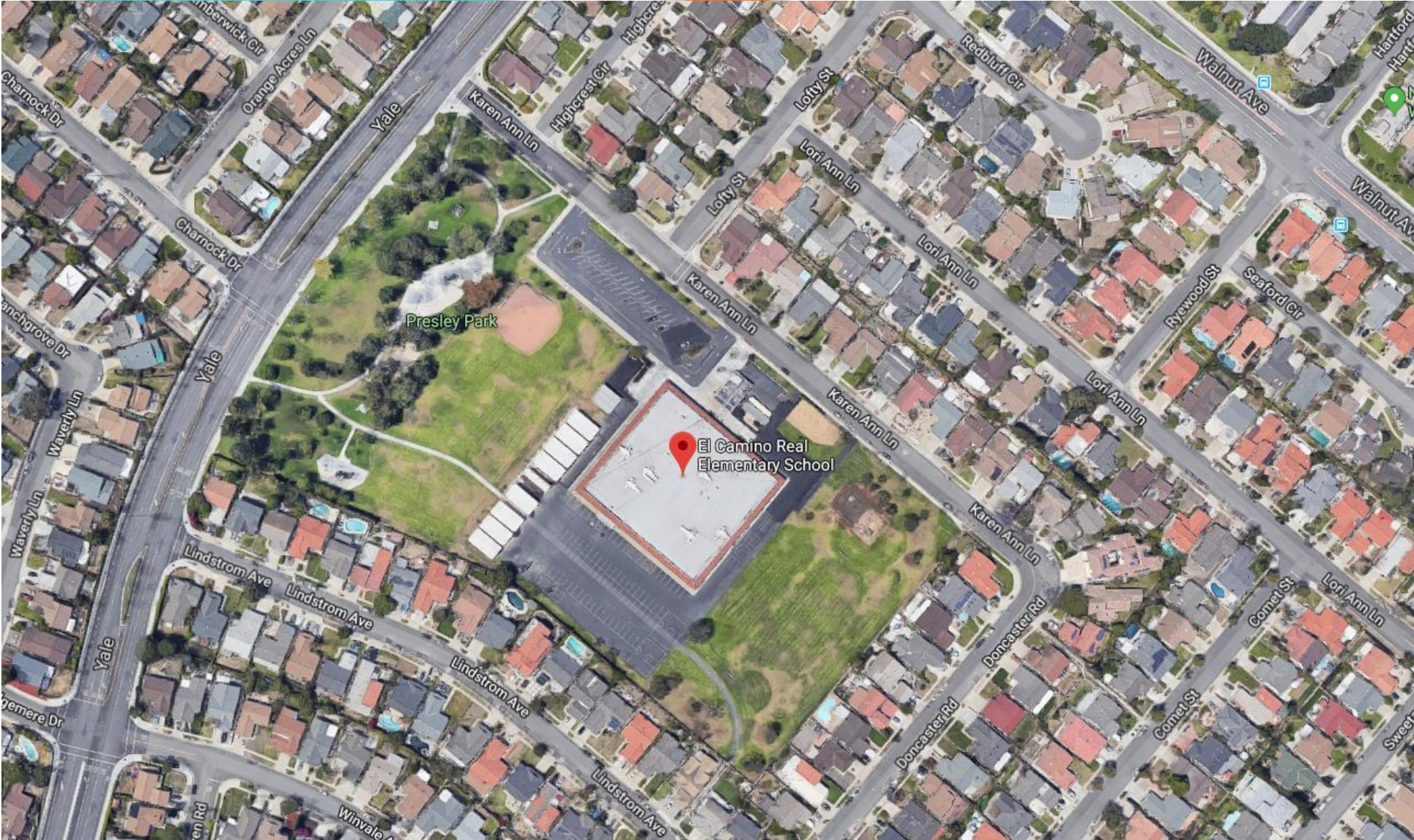

Aerial Map of El Camino: 4782 Karen Ann Ln, Irvine, CA 92604



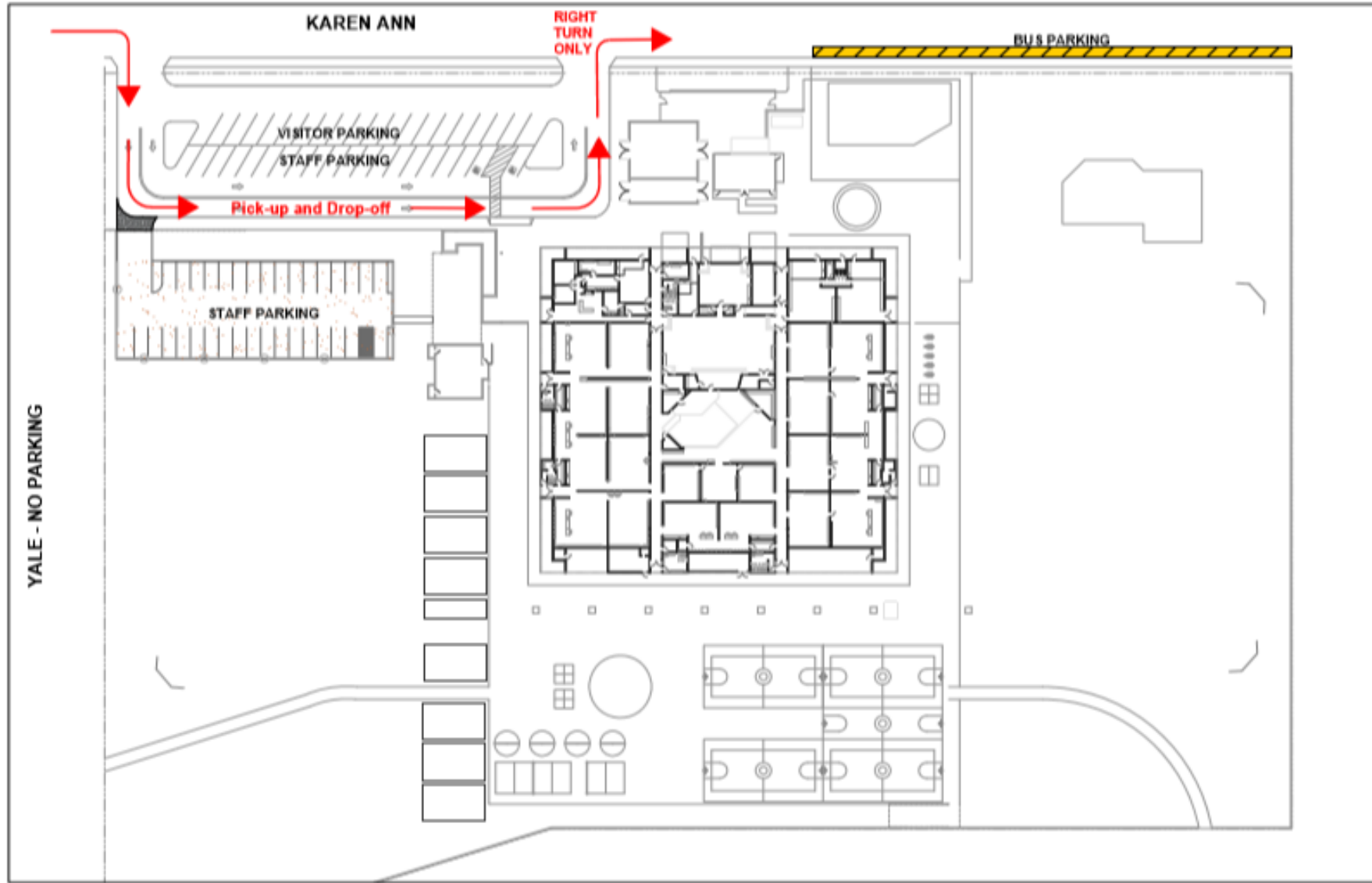

Springbrook Bus Pass Application

One application is needed for EACH student that attends Springbrook in 2019-2020.

Excerpts from Regulations governing Pupil Transportation:

1. Pupils must display Springbrook's Respectful, Responsible, & Ready behavior at all times and obey the instructions of the driver.
2. Bus Pass must be shown when requested.
3. Rides may be refused if Bus Pass is not presented.
4. Transfer of this Bus Pass automatically revokes all rights to its use.
5. All students transported in a school bus are under the direct authority of the driver and must follow all school rules.

Violation of Rules of Conduct will result in denial of transportation as follows:

Bus Stops/Childcare

Two Bus Stops:

1. **Springbrook Elementary (Springbrook North Street)**
2. **Wintermist Park**

Note:

Boys and Girls Club: There will be a drop off for students enrolled at the Boys and Girls Club. This is subject to Boys and Girls Club enrollment. Boys and Girls Club is an independently run organization.

CDC: CDC Will be onsite at El Camino next year so students who attend CDC will be dropped off by parents for morning CDC, and picked up by parents for afternoon CDC.

Bus Pass Distribution

- ❑ **Bus Passes will be distribute at the El Camino location the week before school begins.**
- ❑ **Our front office will contact families with specifics dates and times over the summer.**
- ❑ **There will be an afternoon and morning pick-up option for bus passes.**
- ❑ **Passes will only be handed to parent or legal guardian.**
- ❑ **Students MUST have a pass in order to ride the bus each day.**



Busing FAQs

□1. Q: What happens when a student is not picked up at a drop off location?

□A: This applies to K through 3rd grade or students that are specifically noted by the parent that they must be received: “The driver will not release a child who “must be received” unless you (or a person designated by you) is there to receive him/her. If the bus arrives and no one is at the bus stop to receive him/her, our office will attempt to reach you and/or your emergency contacts by phone. The driver may attempt to return to the stop after others have been dropped off if contact has been made. Your child will be taken back to the school, or to an alternate District facility, if staff is still on site. If the school or facility is not staffed and we have been unable to reach you, the Irvine Police or Orange County Child Protective Services will be contacted, and the child will be given over into their care.”

□2. Q: How long does the bus driver stay at the stop before leaving in the morning?

□A: A.M. – all students are required to arrive at their bus stops (five) 5 minutes before the scheduled departure time. P.M. – will remain at drop off until all students are released.

□3. Q: Will there be additional adult supervision (other than the driver) on the bus?

□A: No

□4. Q: Will there be IUSD staff stationed at the bus stops?

□A: No



Busing FAQs Cont'd

□ 5. Q: Do the buses have seat belts?

□ A: Buses provided by Durham School Services must provide buses with seat belts per contract.

□ The NITSA contract states: *“California requires three-point seat belts on (1) school buses manufactured on and after July 1, 2005 that carry more than 16 passengers, and (2) all other school buses manufactured on and after July 1, 2004. It asks school transportation providers to first allocate seat-belt equipped school buses for elementary school students whenever possible. The state cannot charge any person, school district, or organization with violating this law if a passenger either does not fasten his or her seat belt, or does so improperly (Cal. Veh. Code § 27316).*

□ *State regulations require school bus passengers to (1) use the seat belts; and (2) be taught how to use them in an age-appropriate manner (Cal. Code Regs. Title 5, § 14105).”*

□ 6. Q: Do primary and upper grade students ride together?

□ A: Yes

□ 7. Q: Can we bring musical instruments on the bus?

□ A: Yes



Busing FAQs Cont'd

□8. Q: If we left something on the bus who do we contact?

□A: The Transportation Department at 949-936-5370.

□9. Q: If we are running late, can we hop to the next stop?

□A: No. Students can only enter and exit at the bust stop that they have agreed to. Please see attached bus stop locations.

□10. Q: How are we notified if the bus is running late?

□A: The Transportation Department will notify Springbrook staff and the school will send out information through School Messenger and staff will be dispatched to drop-off location.

□11. Q: If there is an issue on the bus do we contact the school or transportation?

□A: We request that you contact the Transportation Department at 949-936-5370.
